Dear Mr. Brown:

Perhaps you neglected to inform your client that the directive to end communication as conveyed to me in your July 27, 2006 letter is reciprocal. This recent Tuesday, December 11, 2007 at 11:47 AM, both caller id devices connected to my home phone line logged a call from your client's home phone number, 368-3402, and name, Mabel M Savage.

Omitting your extraneous remarks and fallacious implication that your client could and possibly would pursue legal action related to my communication with anyone other than herself, your July 27, 2006 letter stated, "Any future communication to Mrs. Savage will deemed to be harassment".

I was informed in January of this year that Mrs. Savage contacted one of my deceased wife's friends. The purpose of her call was to solicit a confrontation with me as though her statements originated from this individual. Certainly, you understand the legal definition and recourse associated with harassment. Each letter you composed to me defied my formal, written correspondence previously received by your client.

Whether you failed to properly advise your client or she chooses to ignore her own directive, no legitimate reason exists for her to communicate with me. The bottom line, Sir, is her harassments must cease. She had ample opportunity to formally apologize for her deplorable behavior and to provide lawful justification for each item requested.

Of course, Mrs. Savage may pursue any legal action she so desires. Unless in the committed and active pursuit of such action, post filing, neither yourself nor anyone on her behalf contact me via any means or method ever again.
